World Hunger Sunday: Today we are having an offering to support the work of World Renew and help put food on tables around the world. World Renew has the plans, systems, partners, and people to come alongside communities experiencing hunger. We are excited to join this program as a faithful response to the God who can accomplish abundantly more than all we ask or imagine. Thank you for giving as you are able to help solve World Hunger.

Today is Preparatory Sunday. Lord willing, we will celebrate the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper next Sunday morning Nov. 8. As we did for our previous communion all the bread will be cut and arranged in individual cups, and the Elders will be wearing masks for the distribution of the elements. For the south side of the sanctuary where we are practicing social distancing, the Elders will move between the rows holding the trays so that individuals can receive the elements directly. If the south side fills, the Elders will set up additional chairs in the back so that people can receive communion directly. On the north side, the communion trays will be passed down the rows as we traditionally do. Finally, members who would rather have the pre-packaged wafer and juice or who are celebrating communion from home via the livestream, are encouraged to pick up the cups from the church office during this week's office hours (M-F, 9-11:30).
